Publishing Tool
Each Destination article piece will need to be authored by an Editor through the publication tool via an interface created for that purpose. Older Destination article pieces will be archived and accessible to users.

The three columns here are demonstrative only, although we feel that there is some value in this type of split.

Particular word groups can be selected as a search objects which when clicked will result in a search of the indexed/cached database for that group of words and results will be displayed in 20.1 Search Results.

Method for carrying out search

Method for selecting articles to display (if needed)

Clicking an article name will link to article in its primary location within the subject matter hierarchy.
